

## SAN FRANCISCO COLLABORATIVE AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING TEEN WRITING CONTEST 2017

# Contest Theme: "Stolen people, stolen dreams."

Human Trafficking, known as modern day slavery, is making a person work or sell themselves by threats, physical or psychological force, fraud or coercion, and includes the forced labor or sexual exploitation of children. The FBI identified the San Francisco Bay Area as a hot spot for human trafficking in the United States.

**Eligibility:** The contest is open to middle and high school students attending public, private, or home schools in San Francisco and the greater Bay Area.

#### **Contest Rules:**

- Writing must not exceed 500 words.
- Original writing ONLY (no previously written or published materials).
- The document can be printed, typed or written legibly (illegible submissions will be rejected).
- Writing can be completed by an individual or in groups of up to 3 members.
- Limit of one entry per student or group.
- The contest theme "Stolen people, stolen dreams" must be addressed in the writing itself.
- The submitted writing will be judged for its compelling message and originality.
